

POMONA FERTILLIZER

Pomona All-Purpose Plant Food

- ✓ Slow release, organic microbial origin that only releases with micro-organisms
- ✓ Enhances overall plant root development
- ✓ Benefits all garden plants
- √ Safe around children and pets
- ✓ Stimulates micro-organism activity in the soil
- **✓** Does not harm the environment

Application Rates

- Lawn apply 12 pounds/1,000 square feet 3 times per year in March, June and September. For greener turf, apply every 6 weeks from March to September for a total of 5 applications. Set Scott's Edge Guard Rotary Spreader on setting 15.
- Shrubs and Ground Cover apply 1 to 2 pounds/100 square feet 3 times per year in March, June and September
- Newly Planted Trees apply 2 cups around each tree 3 times per year in March, June and September. Spread fertilizer evenly around the tree from trunk out to 2 feet past dripline of tree.
- Fruit Trees apply 2 cups around each tree 3 times per year in March, June and September. Spread fertilizer evenly around the tree from trunk out to 2 feet past dripline of tree.
- Garden Soil Preparation apply 1/3 cup per square yard one time per year when cultivating soil
- Vegetable Plants apply 1/3 cup per square yard every 6 to 8 weeks
- Flower Garden apply 1/3 cup per square yard every 6 to 8 weeks
- Outdoor Container Plants apply 1/8 cup for each 10" of pot size every 6 to 8 weeks

Note: Sweep or blow fertilizer off your walks and drives before watering to avoid stains on the concrete. Water in fertilizer after each application. On trees planted between curb and sidewalk, water in fertilizer with a hose.
